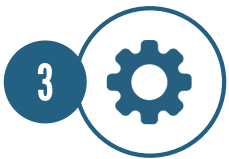
World-Class Location

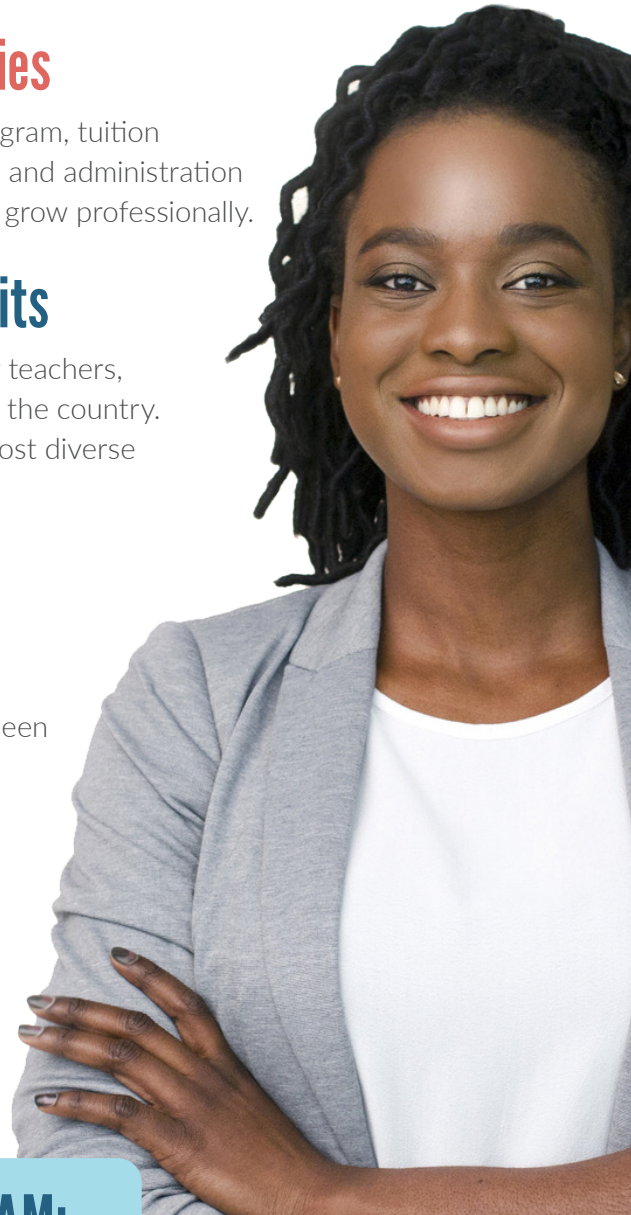
Progressive Community Involvement

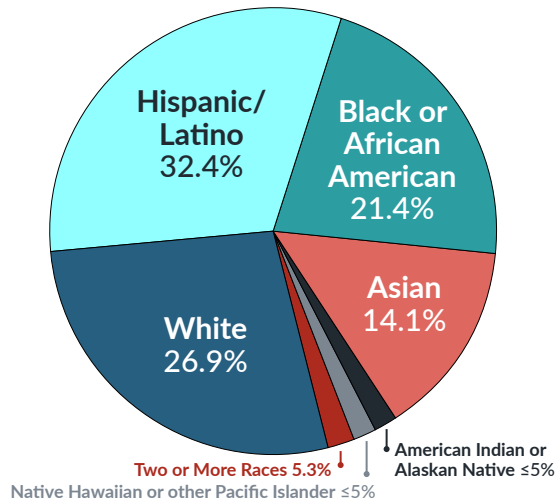

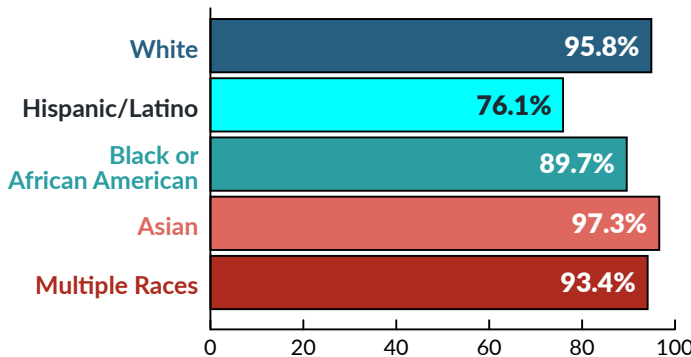

The MCPS overall graduation rate is ABOVE the state and national average.

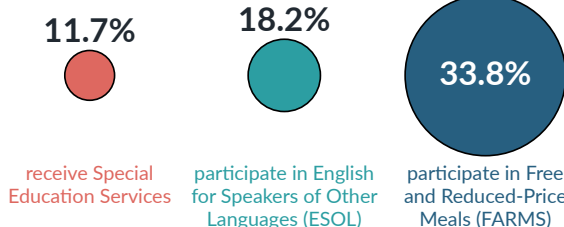
